## Commuting Around the World

People around the world commute to work. Some walk, some drive and some take the bus or train. Here are some other ways people get to work.

### **Copenhagen, Denmark.**

This city is very bicycle-friendly. About 90% of the people there have a bicycle, and over 40% of commuters go to work or school by bicycle. The city has 400 kilometres of bike paths.

### **Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam.**

About nine million people live in this city, and about 70% of them go to work or school by motorbike. People like motorbikes because they're good for short trips and they aren't expensive.

### **La Paz, Bolivia.**

The city is famous for its trams. Many people use them to get to work or school. Melbourne has 24 tram lines and about 490 tram cars. Melbourne's trams are famous. They are popular with people from Melbourne and tourists.
